

Crisis & Transitional Supports

The [Griffin Community Support Network](#) provides time-limited crisis and transitional supports to individuals (aged 16 and over) with a developmental disability or a dual diagnosis (including mental health needs) living in the city of Toronto. The Network is linked to the Dual Diagnosis Resource Service (Centre for Addiction and Mental Health) as well as the Toronto Network of Specialized Care.

How To Apply

Individuals with a developmental disability and/or their families and service providers can access the Network by calling the intake line at 416-222-3563 from 9am to 9pm. Leave a message and a worker will call you back. For immediate mobile crisis response call the Toronto Coordinated Crisis Services.
